

Dear Patient,

Beginning on May 26, we will enable limited visiting for some of our patients. At this time, visiting will only be available in the areas designated for patients who have tested negative for COVID-19.

From 1pm – 5pm daily, one visitor 18 years or older will be allowed per day. Visitors must stop at the Concierge Desk in the Lobby of Building 6, show ID, and obtain a Pass. There, they will be screened for COVID and have a temperature check. Before they can come up to the unit, they must sanitize their hands and use a mask.

Once visitors arrive on the unit, they will be directed to the correct patient room. They must gel their hands before entering the room, and must remain inside the patient room with mask on for the duration of the visit. At the end of their visit, they must gel upon exiting the room, and return the Pass to the Concierge Desk.

Our hospital has the right to suspend the visit at any time, for any reason.

We have established this policy because we do understand how comforting it is for patients to have a visitor during a hospital stay. But we also want to do everything we possibly can to protect you, our staff, and your visitor.
