### Activity Therapist

Assignment Level I  
Annual Salary: \$45,523.00 - \$52,351.00  
(based on full time schedule)

- A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college including or supplemented by 18 credits in recreation, physical education, dance, fine arts, applied arts (including therapy) and 12 credits in psychology, social psychology, group work, group dynamics and/or related field; or
- A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college and one year of full-time experience in planning, coordinating and supervising a recreation activities program in a hospital, health care or related facility; or
- A satisfactory combination of education and/or experience equivalent to 1 or 2 above. However, all candidates must possess a baccalaureate degree.

Assignment Level III  
Annual Salary: \$56,317 - \$64,764 (based on full time schedule)

In addition to meeting the requirements for Assignment Levels I, Assignment Level III requires:

- Three years of full-time experience as described in two (2) above.

### Addiction Counselor

Assignment Level I  
Annual Salary: \$54,026.00 - \$62,130.00 (based on full time schedule)

- Valid Credentialed Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Counselor (CASAC) - Level 1 Certificate issued by the NYS Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (OASAS); or
- Is otherwise considered a Qualified Health Professional (QHP) based on licensure, certification and/or registration along with appropriate experience and/or training as defined in Section 800.3 (I) of the OASAS Treatment Services: General Provisions, Title 14 NYCRR Part 800 (<https://www.oasas.ny.gov/regs/documents/800.pdf>).

Assignment Level II  
Annual Salary: \$58,398 - \$67,158 (based on full time schedule)

- Must be a Certified Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Counselor (CASAC) or be in the process to take the certification exam Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Counselor Trainee (CASAC-T). A Baccalaureate Degree from an accredited college including or supplemented by 24 credits in Psychology, Sociology, Social Work, or related behavioral science and one year of full-time paid experience performing rehabilitation counseling or casework in a drug or alcohol addiction treatment program; or
- High school graduation or evidence of having passed an examination for a High School Equivalency diploma and three years of full-time paid experience as described above; or
- Three years of experience as a resident or patient in a drug or alcohol addiction therapeutic community or program recognized by the Health & Hospitals Corporation, including one year in a supervisory capacity; or
- A satisfactory equivalent.

#### Special Notes:

1. For placement in Assignment Level II, candidates must possess one year of experience in Assignment Level I or an additional year of related full-time experience.
2. Completion of a recognized apprenticeship program in the application of acupuncture treatments is required to be eligible to provide treatment in an acupuncture modality.

### Senior Addiction Counselor Level II

- Valid Credentialed Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Counselor (CASAC) - Level 2 Certificate issued by the NYS Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (OASAS); or
- Is otherwise considered a Qualified Health Professional (QHP) based on licensure, certification and/or registration along with appropriate experience and/or training as defined in Section 800.3 (I) of the OASAS Treatment Services: General Provisions, Title 14 NYCRR Part 800 (<https://www.oasas.ny.gov/regs/documents/800.pdf>).

### Assistant Director, Grants

Annual Salary: \$102,000 (based on full time schedule)

- Baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university in Public or Business Administration or a related discipline and 3 (three) years of progressively responsible experience in areas relating to public administration and/or health care planning and administration, grant writing, and work related to grants management and development within these fields.
- Master's degree from an accredited college or university in disciplines, as listed in #11 above, can be substituted for one (1) year of experience, as described in "1" above.

### Creative Arts Therapist-Level II
