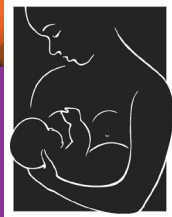

DIRECTIONS TO WOODHULL

NYC Health + Hospitals/ Woodhull is located at the intersection of Broadway and Flushing Avenue.

By Subway

Take the J, M, or Z train to Flushing Avenue. Take the elevators or stairs to reach the southwest corner of Broadway and Flushing, where the main entrance is located.

Alternatively, take the G train to Flushing Avenue, then take the B57 bus or walk three blocks east toward Broadway, and the main entrance.

By Car

From Brooklyn: Take the Brooklyn-Queens Expressway (BQE) to the Flushing Avenue exit; turn right onto Flushing Avenue; then continue to Woodhull.

From Queens: Take the BOE to McGuinness Blvd (the first exit over the Kosciuszko Bridge); at the third light, turn left onto Humboldt Street (under the bridge), which leads directly to Woodhull. You may take the Jackie Robinson (Interboro) Parkway, to the Bushwick Ave. exit; continue to Myrtle Ave; turn left on Myrtle and go to Throop Ave; turn right on Throop, then continue to Woodhull.

From Manhattan: Follow the Williamsburg Bridge to Broadway (the first exit), and turn left; go straight to Woodhull. You may take the Brooklyn Bridge, by going to Tillary St. (the first light); turn left and go to the BOE; exit at Flushing Avenue; turn right, then go to Woodhull.

Welcome to our Maternity Services, we recognize it is a special time for you and your family. We are here to ensure your experience is safe and satisfying.

We are a team of midwives, obstetricians, perinatologists, nurses, neonatologists, anesthesiologists, and ancillary staff dedicated to partnering with and serving you.

We are the 1st Baby-Friendly, USA Hospital in Brooklyn. This means that we encourage mother and baby bonding from the first moments of your newborn's life.



Skin to Skin

- + Your baby will be placed directly on your skin immediately after birth, together you will experience skin to skin contact and will begin to bond assuming there are no complications.
- + Our dedicated team is here to support you. You can receive support from your loved ones as well during the birth of your baby.

Mother Baby Suite

- + We have all private and very spacious rooms that are available at no additional cost. Your newborn will stay with you during your entire hospital stay.
- + Our staff is here to support and prepare for when you go home with your newborn.
- + Our dedicated nursing staff will teach and/or review the basics of newborn care and will answer any questions you may have. We offer a "Mommy and Me" class and encourage all patients to attend before being discharged.
- + We have a lactation counselor who can provide you with breastfeeding support.

- + We recognize that healing after childbirth is important. To honor this, from 2:00 PM - 4:00 PM we have "Quiet Time" where we turn down the lights on the unit, and impose limitations on noise levels and staff interruptions so that you and your family will be able to bond with your newborn in a peaceful atmosphere, with the exception of any medical needs or emergencies.
- + We are a Safe Sleep certified facility and we provide the ABC's for safe sleep.

Our spacious fully-equipped Neonatal Intensive Care, Intermediate Care/Continuing Care Units

As a Level III nursery and member of the Regional Perinatal Center at Bellevue Hospital, we are capable of caring for the most acutely sick or at-risk newborns.

Our great and dedicated team of neonatologists and nurses will keep you informed and will answer any questions you may have during your stay and before you go home.
