Surgical Technologist (Opening in Operating Room) – Level II Salary \$85,000

Holds and maintains a Certified Surgical Technologist (CST) credential administered by the National Board of Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting (NBSTSA); **or**,

Successful completion of a nationally accredited educational program for surgical technologists or successful completion of an appropriate training program for surgical technology in the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard or Public Health Service Commissioned Corps, and holds and maintains a certified surgical technologist credential administered by a nationally accredited surgical technologist credentialing organization other than the NBSTSA, such as the National Center for Competency Testing (NCCT).

Behavioral Health Associate (Opening in BH Emergency) – Annual Salary \$55,243

An Associate's degree in criminal justice, social services or a health-related area; **or**,
A High School diploma or a G.E.D. and **one (1)** year of full-time experience in law enforcement, nursing or psychiatric/behavioral health in a high volume, intensive care environment.

Successful completion of an appropriate training program in the application and use of restraints and seclusion must be completed prior to an individual performing such work.

Successful completion of an appropriate training in the performance of vital signs and grooming within **ninety (90)** calendar days of appointment to the title.

Special Note: As required by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), Hospital Conditions of Participation - Patients' Rights (42 CFR Part 482), before applying restraints, implementing seclusion, performing associated monitoring of the restrained or secluded individual, or providing care for such individual, staff must be trained and able to demonstrate competency in the performance of these actions.

Psychiatric Social Health Technician (Opening in BH Emergency) – Part Time Annual Salary \$30,092 – Full Time Annual Salary \$50,154

High school diploma or its educational equivalent, approved by a State's Department of Education or a recognized accrediting organization; **and**,

Successful completion of NYC Health + Hospitals training program in the application and use of restraints and seclusion must be completed prior to an individual performing such work; **and**,

Successful completion of NYC Health + Hospitals training in the performance of vital signs and grooming within **ninety (90)** calendar days of appointment to the title; **and**,

Holds or obtains a valid and current certification in Basic Life Support (BLS) through the American Heart Association (AHA) within sixty (60) calendar days of appointment to the title.
