Our Pride Health Services provide affirming health care to LGBTQ+ New Yorkers. **Providers in these spaces have received extensive training to ensure they deliver culturally responsive care.** Our clinicians are here to address your health needs and answer all your questions in a safe and welcoming environment.

OUR SERVICES

- + Primary care, which includes immunizations, hormone therapy and surgical referrals
- + Behavioral health services and referrals
- + Pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP)
- + Post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP)
- + HIV testing and treatment
- + Sexually transmitted infection (STI) testing and treatment
- + Insurance navigation and enrollment
- + Puberty blockers at Elmhurst, Jacobi, Judson and Metropolitan
- + Affirming OB/GYN care at Bellevue, Elmhurst, Gouverneur, Jacobi, and Lincoln; GYN care only at Judson, Metropolitan and Woodhull

- + Breast implants, Breast augmentation, Mastectomy, Breast reduction, Hysterectomy, Oophorectomy, Cheekbone augmentation, Septoplasty, Genioplasty, Frontal bone reshaping, Frontal brow lift, Frontal sinus reset, Hairline lowering, Rhinoplasty, Tracheal shave, Angle resection
