

World Trade Center 9.11 Health Program Survivor Eligibility



The World Trade Center (WTC) Health Program provides medical monitoring and treatment to eligible survivors who were affected by 9/11. See the checkboxes below to find out if you may be eligible to apply.

Many Survivors receive treatment for certified WTC-related health conditions including:

- Respiratory diseases like asthma and chronic cough
- Digestive disorders, such as acid reflux and GERD
- Mental health conditions like post-traumatic stress disorder
- Cancer
- Acute traumatic injuries

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- ☐ **And are you sick?**
If you have symptoms or are diagnosed with a covered condition related to your 9/11 exposure, you may be eligible to apply. Many don't know their health symptoms may be related to 9/11. Some symptoms are:

- Persistent cough or wheezing
- Chronic heartburn or acid reflux
- Constant runny or stuffy nose
- Trouble sleeping, anxiety, or depression

If you checked both boxes, you may be eligible to apply.



If these boxes do not apply to you and you performed rescue, recovery, or clean-up work in the days and months after 9/11, you may be able to apply as a Responder.
